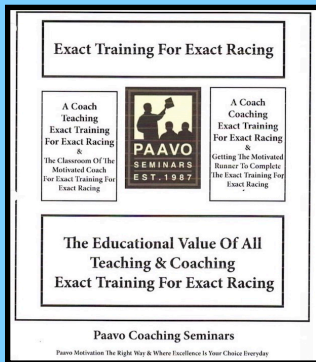

Structures & Guidelines

From Coach Sellers,
Director, Paavo Clinics & Seminars:

Understand the Following:

1. In the past the outlined structures have worked really well. I will continue with that simple process for a coach to register for the upcoming Paavo Clinic. We are not fancy.
2. With that said, out here in Wyoming, a person's word and handshake are still good. I expect the same from coaches who return the registration form in good faith.
3. Once the form is received, I expect you to be at the clinic the first moment on the first day and for the entire clinic presentation schedule. The entire presentation schedule is sequential, basic, and progressive. All parts are dependent on previous parts. The quality of the clinic content is just that. It is the best out there if that concept is adhered to.
4. As we get closer to the clinic date, a coach can still get registered using the form and send by email. Note: Remember I am traveling all the way from Wyoming days ahead of the clinic, but I check emails along the way. Email: coachsellers@paavoseminars.com
5. I trust your word, and the received registration form is your handshake
6. **PAYMENTS: THE CLINIC REGISTRATION FEE IS \$295 Payable to PROMOTIONS MARKETING OR PAAVO SEMINARS.** (Value of not only the 3 full days with the clinic coaches, but the post clinic curriculum supplements as well)
*** If it all possible, please process as soon as you can for I also adhere to a tight budget. We are not big nor do we have big sponsors. We really are grassroots.
*** Payments can be by school check, personal check, money order, School PO, or cash at the check-in the first day. Early payments to the following address is encouraged.

Under penalties of perjury, I certify that:

General Instructions

Section references are to the Internal Revenue Code unless otherwise noted.

Future developments. For the latest information about developments related to Form W-9 and its instructions, such as legislation enacted after they were published, go to www.irs.gov/FormW9.

Purpose of Form

An individual or entity (Form W-9 requester) who is required to file an information return with the IRS must obtain your correct taxpayer identification number (TIN) which may be your social security number (SSN), individual taxpayer identification number (ITIN), adoption taxpayer identification number (ATIN), or employer identification number (EIN), to report on an information return the amount paid to you, or other amount reportable on an information return. Examples of information returns include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Form 1099-DIV (dividends, including those from stocks or mutual funds)
- Form 1099-MISC (various types of income, prizes, awards, or gross proceeds)
- Form 1099-B (stock or mutual fund sales and certain other transactions by brokers)
- Form 1099-S (proceeds from real estate transactions)
- Form 1099-K (merchant card and third party network transactions)
- Form 1098 (home mortgage interest), 1098-E (student loan interest), 1098-T (tuition)
- Form 1099-C (canceled debt)
- Form 1099-A (acquisition or abandonment of secured property)

Use Form W-9 only if you are a U.S. person (including a resident alien), to provide your correct TIN.

If you do not return Form W-9 to the requester with a TIN, you might be subject to backup withholding. See What is backup withholding, later.
